Dear Year 10 and 12 parents/carers,

Over the next five weeks it is likely your child will be returning to Bolingbroke for limited face-to-face provision

We are really looking forward to seeing them return and will be welcoming the first pupils/students from Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June. Please bear in mind it is a maximum of 20 pupils on site from Year 10 and the same for 12. Every child's timetable will be different, so it isn't possible for us to share an individual timetable for each child.

For Year 10, further information on dates/times will be shared at the Parent Information Evening this Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> June at 4pm.

For Year 12, students will not return until the week commencing 22<sup>nd</sup> June following their exams. On site provision for Year 12 will be to support Art and Applied Science. Individuals have been contacted regarding this.

All pupils/students will come in for their lesson and return home immediately afterwards, there will be no lunch provision.

If your child is already attending our Community Classrooms, they can continue to do so regardless of which year group they are in. If you are a key worker and require this provision, please contact Ms Samson at e.samson@arkbolingbrokeacademy.org.

To support the transition during our new norm we require every child to be equipped with the following: -

1. A full pencil case of equipment required for their lesson.
2. Water bottle with water only.
3. Food including sweets or cans / bottles of drink are not permitted on site.
4. Non-uniform to support the daily washing of clothing before return to site.
5. A bag for items – this does not need to be Bolingbroke Academy during this period of time.
6. Pupils/students attending PE will need to bring a laptop if they have one.

On arrival our young people need to follow the following entrance routines: -

1. Art – Wakehurst Road pathway gate (not main foyer) to Art Room
2. Drama (Commons – Courtyard entrance) and Music (Central stairs entrance) via Belleville Road gate
3. PE via Wakehurst Road foyer entrance to S.04
4. GCSE Computer science and Year 12 Applied Science via Wakehurst Road foyer entrance and sign in.
5. Community Classrooms via Wakehurst entrance: -
  - Year 7-9 – F.03
  - Year 10 – S.04
  - Year 12 – M.01

If you arrive early, please wait next to the designated signs on the outside rails. Signs will indicate waiting points.

Please note that there will be no lessons on site or online on our inset days, which are Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> July and Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July.

### **Attendance**

We all have a role to play to stop the spread of infection and we must all continue to follow the NHS guidance. If any pupil/student has symptoms of Coronavirus, however mild, they must not come to school. If a pupil/student shows any symptoms at school, we will contact their parents or carers so we can send them home. Anyone with symptoms must self-isolate and stay at home for at least 7 days from when the symptoms started and they should immediately arrange to have a Coronavirus test. Everyone in the household of someone with symptoms must stay at home for 14 days, or until they receive a negative test result - they should not go to work, school or use public transport or taxis. Nobody should go out even to buy food or other essentials, and any exercise must be taken at home.

If a pupil/student's test is negative, they can come back to school. If the test is positive, they cannot come back to school until they have recovered, the minimum time they must stay at home is 7 days. **If your child has a Coronavirus test, you must let us know the result as soon as possible.** If the test is positive, we will need to advise everyone in their class group to stay home for 14 days.

At school, we will make sure that pupils/students follow the strict hygiene measures required and that they wash their hands often. Please make sure that your child understands how important it is for everyone to wash their hands regularly for 20 seconds using soap and water and that they cough and sneeze safely into a tissue or their elbow. All pupils will be asked to sign the Family Academy agreement attached on their first day on site.

Our teachers and school staff have worked incredibly hard to put all of the measures needed in place to make our school safe, we really appreciate your patience and understanding whilst we made our plans. If you need any further information, please let me know, I look forward to seeing some of our young people back at school very soon. In the meantime, please do encourage your child to continue with their home learning.
